



## Timothy Glover, M.Div. Executive Vice President and Chief Mission Integration Officer, Ascension

Prior to these executive roles he served as a Chaplain and then Coordinator of the Stress Reduction Program and Consultant in Organizational and Change Management for Saint Thomas Hospital.

Prior to his roles in healthcare, Mr. Glover served as a director for a pastoral counseling center and provided individual, couple and family pastoral psychotherapy as a licensed Clinical Pastoral Therapist in Tennessee.

Mr. Glover is a member of the 2020 cohort of the Ascension Leadership Academy and participated in the Ascension Foundations of Ministry Leadership formation program. He holds a Master of Divinity degree in Pastoral Psychotherapy and Family Systems from The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, Kentucky.
